A MUNICIPAL ORDER APPROVING THE APPOINTMENT OF KEVIN CRUMP TO THE TO THE JOINT CODE ENFORCEMENT BOARD FOR A TERM ENDING JULY 1, 2026.

WHEREAS, the interlocal agreement between the City of Paris, City of North Middletown, and Bourbon County related to the Joint Code Enforcement Board authorizes the appointment of two positions to the board by the City Commission;

WHEREAS, there is a need to fill the replacement of Joanne George on the board;

WHEREAS, the interlocal agreement indicates that a member and an alternate will be appointed;

WHEREAS, the initial term of the member shall be one (1) year and the initial term of the alternate shall be three (3) years;

WHEREAS, the subsequent appointments shall be for terms of three (3) years;

WHEREAS, the City has adopted Ordinance No 2019-13 which establishes limits for consecutive terms;

WHEREAS, the recommended appointment is for an initial term as an alternate member

NOW THEREFORE be it resolved by the Board of Commissioners of the City of Paris that the appointment of Kevin Crump to the Joint Code Enforcement Board is approved for a term ending July 1, 2026
