JOB SUMMARY The Chief of Police for The City of Paris manages approximately 50 employees (30 sworn officers). The Chief of Police has overall responsibility for enforcing the law, overseeing emergency dispatch, community engagement, and administration for department including the budget. This is an appointed leadership position reporting directly to the City Manager and is responsible for planning, directing, supervising and coordinating the activities of the City Police Department in the areas of law enforcement and crime prevention.
