Paris Selects Rumpke for Trash and Recycling

Service Begins Week of December 3, 2018

PARIS, Kentucky – October 22, 2018 – The City of Paris has selected Rumpke Waste & Recycling as its weekly trash and recycling service provider, beginning December 3, 2018.

Recycling Reminders

As a reminder, residents can recycle the following household items:

- Plastic bottles and jugs (please flatten and reattached the lid)
- Glass bottles and jars (any color)
- Aluminum beverage cans
- Steel cans
- Empty aerosol cans (with lids and tips removed)
- Paperboard (cereal boxes, 12-pack containers, etc.)
- Cardboard
- A variety of paper products, including: office paper, newspaper, magazines, junk mail and envelopes (with or without windows), telephone books, paper grocery bags.

Recyclables should be placed into bins loose and not contained in plastic bags.
