ORDINANCE 2026-10**

AN ORDINANCE LEVYING CITY OF PARIS AD VALOREM TAXES FOR GENERAL MUNICIPAL PURPOSES FOR THE FISCAL YEAR OF 2026-2027 ON REAL PROPERTY WITHIN THE TAXING JURISDICTION OF THE CITY OF PARIS SHALL BE AT THE RATE OF \$0.1190 PER ONE HUNDRED (\$100.00) DOLLARS OF ASSESSED VALUATION.

Be it ordained by the City of Paris:

Section I: That for the purpose of general support of the government of City of Paris, and the payment of its debts and expenses for the fiscal year 2026-2027, there be and hereby, are levied ad valorem taxes on each one hundred (\$100.00) dollars of the January 1, 2026, assessed valuation by the Bourbon County Property Valuation Administrator of all real property within the taxing jurisdiction of the City of Paris, which shall be at the rate of \$0.1190.

Section II: All taxes not paid by the 4:30 p.m. EST on the 30th day of December 2026 shall be subject to a penalty of ten percent (10%) plus interest at the rate of twelve percent (12%) per annum.

Section III: This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and publication in full as required by law, with an effective date of July 1, 2026.

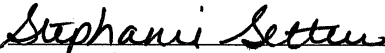

ORDINANCE 2026-11**

AN ORDINANCE LEVYING CITY OF PARIS AD VALOREM TAXES FOR GENERAL MUNICIPAL PURPOSES FOR THE FISCAL YEAR OF 2026-2027 ON PERSONAL PROPERTY, OTHER THAN MOTOR VEHICLES AND WATERCRAFT, WITHIN THE TAXING JURISDICTION OF THE CITY OF PARIS SHALL BE AT THE RATE OF \$ 0.2280 PER ONE HUNDRED (\$100.00) DOLLARS OF ASSESSED VALUATION.

Be it ordained by the City of Paris:

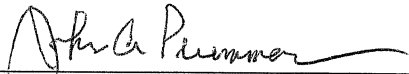
Section I: That for the purpose of general support of the government of the City of Paris, and the payment of its debts and expenses for the fiscal year 2026-2027, there be and hereby, are levied ad valorem taxes on each one hundred (\$100.00) dollars of the January 1, 2026 assessed valuation by the Bourbon County Property Valuation Administrator of all personal property, other than motor vehicles and watercraft, within the taxing jurisdiction of the City of Paris, which shall be at the rate of \$0.2280.

Section II: All taxes not paid by 4:30 p.m. EST on the 30th day of December 2026 shall be subject to a penalty of ten percent (10%) plus interest at the rate of twelve percent (12%) per annum.

Section III: This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and publication in full as required by law, with an effective date of July 1, 2026.

The foregoing ordinance was introduced and read for the first time at the City Commission's regular meeting of August 25, 2026. Read for the second time, adopted, and approved at its special meeting of September 11, 2026.

AN ORDINANCE LEVYING CITY OF PARIS AD VALOREM TAXES FOR GENERAL MUNICIPAL PURPOSES FOR THE CALENDAR YEAR OF 2027 ON MOTOR VEHICLES AND WATERCRAFT WITHIN THE TAXING JURISDICTION OF THE CITY OF PARIS SHALL BE THE RATE OF \$0.170 PER ONE HUNDRED (\$100.00) DOLLARS OF ASSESSED VALUATION.

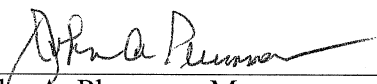
Be it ordained by the City of Paris:

Section 1: That for the purpose of general support of the government of the City of Paris, and the payment of its debts and expenses for the calendar year of 2027, there be and hereby are levied ad valorem taxes on each one hundred (\$100.00) dollars of the January 1, 2027 assessed valuation by the Bourbon County Property Valuation Administrator of all motor vehicles and watercraft within the taxing jurisdiction of the City of Paris which shall be at the rate of \$0.170.

Section 2: This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and publication in full as required by law, with an effective date of January 1, 2027.

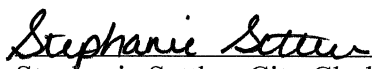

**CITY OF PARIS
ORDINANCE 2026-13**

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING DISCOUNT TO REAL PROPERTY TAX

Whereas, the City has adopted Ordinance No. 2026-10 established the ad valorem tax to be calculated and due for real property in the City, and

Whereas, KRS 91A.070(2)(d) permits the City to establish by ordinance a discount for early payment of ad valorem taxes;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF PARIS CITY COMMISSION AS FOLLOWS:

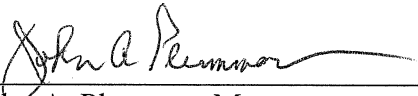
The Board of Commissioners of the City of Paris desires to allot for a discount for the early payment of ad valorem taxes on real property. Any 2026 real property ad valorem tax that is paid in full on or before November 30, 2026, shall be discounted by the amount of two percent (2%).

In order to qualify for the discount under this Ordinance, the entire discounted payment must be received by the city at its Municipal Building, 525 High Street, no later than 4:30 p.m. EST Monday, November 30, 2026.

The foregoing ordinance shall take effect immediately upon execution and publication.

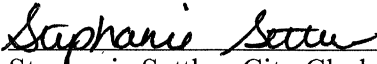
